

# **ABOUT KHASTO**

Khasto is an Indian-Dutch family business founded in the 1980s and based in Amsterdam. Our products are a testament to textile artisans' skills and their rich history. A signature characteristic of Khasto products is the use of layers of soft, thin cotton, also known as 'voile', which provides ultimate comfort through its softness.

Our main collection is named *The Cotton Cashmere Collection*. These products are made of three layers of very thin voile. Our unique prints, which are inspired by the artistic Mughal period, are applied to the middle layer, becoming visible through the outer layers. In addition to this, we have a yearly changing *Block Print Collection* that consists of two layers. This collection features a layer of cotton with a hand block printed design on the outside and an inner layer of Khasto's signature voile. This makes the collection more colorful, slightly lighter and soft.

Khasto is a slow fashion brand. We value traditional techniques and the use of organic materials. We use only 100% organically grown cotton in our products, audited by top-level certification from the Global Textile Exchange. Additionally, we guarantee fair working conditions and environmentally responsible use of chemicals. The fabric of the annually changing Block Print Collection is printed entirely by hand. We are certified for the Organic Content Standard (OCS100) and Global Organic Textile Standard (GOTS). Specifications are listed at the end of this catalog (page 46).

Khasto has decades long partnerships with the manufacturers, as well as family living in the production area. Our partnerships are based on trust, transparency and a shared vision of preserving traditional techniques.



# THE COTTON CASHMERE COLLECTION


Known as The Cotton Cashmere, our three layered soft cotton collection of bed linen and nightwear is born from a history of intertwined traditions.

In the 18th century, the Nepalese princess Damber Kumari went on a journey to Benares, a holy city in India known for its rich history in fabrics. During her stay, she discovered the Indian art of block printing on cotton. Fascinated by this craft, she learned its secrets.

When returning to Nepal, Princess Damber Kumari wanted to enhance this beautiful technique, inspired by the colder Nepalese climate, she sewed two layers of fine cotton (voile) on both sides of the printed fabric. To her delight, the three layers regulated heat, made the garment breathable, and added a touch of softness and elegance. The outer layers were so thin that the middle layer's colorful patterns remained visible, creating a mesmerizing effect.

This magical fabric, primarily used as a shawl, became known as Damber Kumari Khasto. In Nepali, 'Khasto' means 'scarf,' and it inspired other variations like the Pashmina Khasto and the Dhaka Khasto. Meanwhile, in India, this three-layered marvel is cherished as the 'dohar.' Thus, the tale of Damber Kumari and her innovative Khasto shawl weaves its way through history, a testament to creativity, tradition, and the enduring allure of handcrafted textiles.

Fast forward in time: In the late 1990s, an Indian friend of Khasto's founder gave her one of these Nepalese Damber Kumari Khasto as a gift. With our own Mughal era inspired prints and a fine voile, Khasto designed a new collection of nightwear, children's and baby clothes, accessories, bedding and meditation wear. Gradually, we and our customers have come to call the three-layer material the 'cotton cashmere', because the cotton has a softness that is comparable to the well known cashmere. This Cotton Cashmere Collection has grown to become a one-of-a-kind collection, with a unique softness, worldwide.



# THE BLOCK PRINT COLLECTION

The word 'block print' says it all: a technique of printing textiles with a wooden block. Patterns are drawn on pieces of wood and then carved with thin chisels. The Indian Rosewood tree (also known as Sheesham wood) is often used for this because these species are harder and therefore more suitable for cutting shapes without damaging the wood. The finished block looks like a relief work of art, similar to an etching, revealing the shapes of the print.

We chose block printing because we value its unique warmth and depth of colors, with each work having a personal signature from the printer. The visible craftsmanship and beauty of block print cannot be replaced with modern printing techniques, wearing a block print contributes to the preservation of this craft.

Although the block printer cannot avoid irregularities, they only have one chance to get the print right. Each color requires a separate block. So one block is placed, followed by another, sometimes up to ten blocks. The result of this printing method is a beautifully warm, handmade appearance, each piece carrying the unique signature of the artisan.







## FAIRTRADE & SUSTAINABILITY

## Khasto GOTS-certified products are:

#### Organic

Organic fibres are natural fibres grown without the use of synthetic pesticides, or herbicides and GMOs according to the principles of organic agriculture. Organic agriculture is a production process that sustains the health of ecosystems, soils and people.

#### Ethically made

GOTS social criteria, based on the key norms of the International Labour Organisation (ILO), United Nations Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights (UNGPs) and Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD), must be met by all processors, manufacturers and traders.

#### Environmentally friendly

In the processing of organically produced fibers, a clear separation from conventional materials is necessary to ensure the unequivocal identification of organic products. Stringent requirements are established for the use of chemical additives such as dyes and auxiliaries concerning their toxicity and biodegradability. Additionally, certain problematic additives are prohibited in this context.

### Traceable from field to final product

GOTS is a holistic standard, with comprehensive and strict requirements for the entire textile supply chain. This ensures full traceability from field to finished product starting with the raw material allowed and continuing through the next stages of processing; spinning, weaving and knitting, wet-processing, manufacturing, packaging, labelling, and trading, all the way to the final distribution of organic textile products. GOTS consists solely of mandatory criteria. For the end product to carry a GOTS label, every company that is part of the process must be certified.

#### Certified by third-party experts

On-site inspection and certification of processors, manufacturers and traders is performed by independent Third-Party GOTS accredited Certification Bodies and forms the basis of the GOTS monitoring system. It serves to provide a credible assurance for the integrity of GOTS certified textiles.

Made only in facilities which adhere to the strict GOTS criteria - from field to final product The GOTS certification system begins with the cultivation of organic fibres and extends to cover all subsequent stages of processing, manufacturing, and trade in organic textiles. All aspects must be certified according to strict ecological and social criteria for the final product to bear the GOTS label. In this way, GOTS puts an end to "greenwashing."

# ORDER PROCEDURE

Direct orders - Bestsellers stock only

You can place direct orders at khasto.com/b2b and click 'direct-orders'.

We ask for a minimum order value of € 1000,- (ex VAT if applicable).

The processing time is approximately 3-7 business days.

#### Regular orders

We ask for a minimum order value of € 1000,- (ex VAT if applicable). The delivery time is approximately 12 weeks.

You can place regular orders at khasto.com/b2b. There are 5 yearly order moments (we will notify you in advance). Currently they are scheduled as follows:

Order moments 2024 - Complete collection 15th SEPTEMBER - delivery 20th November 2024 1st DECEMBER - delivery 20th March 2025

Order moments 2025 - Cotton Cashmere Collection only 20th JANUARY - delivery 15th April 1st APRIL - delivery 1st July 20th AUGUST - delivery 10th November

Order moments 2025 - Complete collection 15th SEPTEMBER - delivery 20th November 2025 1st DECEMBER - delivery 20th March 2026

### High-volume orders

Orders above € 7.500 can be placed at any moment with a delivery time of 10-12 weeks (regardless of above mentioned 5 moments, and earlier if we can deliver from direct stock).

\*Please be aware that direct and regular orders are not added up. Each order type must be fulfilled with its own conditions, minimums and payment terms.

#### Placing an order

You can place your order online at www.khasto.com/b2b.

We ask you to make an advance payment of 50% at online checkout, when placing a regular order. For first orders, the payment of the second half can be done before delivery. For second and following orders, the payment of the second half can be done within 30 days after delivery.

Direct orders can be paid in full at online checkout.

#### Shipping costs

For all orders we charge actual shipping costs.
